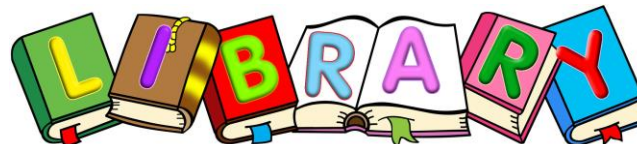

NEW PARENT/STUDENT INFORMATION PORTAL

Over the summer, Frederick County Public Schools replaced Edline with a new student information system from Tyler Technologies called Parent/Student 360. The new system will provide parents with access to a variety of information including student schedules, grades and attendance data. Shortly after the start of the 2016-17 school year, parents will receive a user name and password that will allow them to login to Parent/Student 360 to access information regarding their student(s). The Parent/Student 360 link can be found under the Parent & Students tab on the Frederick County Public Schools website (www.frederick.k12.va.us) and each individual school website.

COMMUNICATIONS AND MEDIA ACCESS

Parents and eligible students **must** annually notify the office of the student's school in writing if they don't want the school division or the media to have access to their image, voice recordings or other similar identifying information during school-day operations; otherwise, they will be deemed to have given their permission for publications.

MY SCHOOL BUCKS

Credit Card Payment System

Parents or guardians are encouraged to use the online payment system, MySchoolBucks, to pay school activity fees and place money on a student's cafeteria account. Parents are able to view current account balances, review recent purchases, receive low-balance alerts, and setup recurring payments on a weekly or monthly basis if desired. Once the payment is made, a receipt is automatically sent to the purchaser and teacher notifying them that a payment has been received. Visa and MasterCard are accepted 24 hours a day. The website is user friendly and allows you to self-register.

Register on the school's website or on the FCPS homepage. Look for the MySchoolBucks Payment link. Also, there is a supply of brochures available to take home in the front office.

RETURNED CHECKS

Frederick County Public Schools has an agreement with a third party administrator for the collection of all returned checks. If your check is returned by your bank, it will be automatically forwarded to a third party administrator after the first presentation. They will collect the face amount of the returned check plus the maximum collection fee allowable by law. Further action within the limits of law may be taken if you do not properly respond and Frederick County Public Schools may elect to cease accepting checks from you.

Please help limit classroom interruptions & protect instructional time!

We request parent/guardian cooperation with the following procedures:

Bus Notes / Transportation Changes

If your child is to ride the bus home with another student or will be picked up by another student's parent, **BOTH students MUST have signed permission notes from their parent/guardian:**

- Stating their student's name
- The name of the student they will be riding home with
- The bus number they will be riding
- Teacher's name

Arrangements should be made **prior-to** students leaving home in the morning. Students will not be permitted to call home to initiate a change in transportation.

Early Pick-up

If you are picking your child up early, please send a note with your child to the office with:

- The time the student is to be picked up
- The reason for early dismissal
- The name of the person picking up your child
- Teacher's name

A parent/guardian (or approved party) must come into the main office and sign your student out.

Be prepared to show a picture ID when picking up your child.

Excessive unexcused early releases within each nine weeks results in disciplinary action

Emergency – Unplanned Changes Throughout the Day

Please make every effort to notify the office for transportation changes **AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE** in the school day!! Call 540-662-4781 We understand emergency situations and other unforeseeable situations will occur. We do ask that you please pre-plan whenever possible to minimize unnecessary class-time interruptions.

Consistent Changes – if you have a consistent schedule change in place for your child, send a note to the front office (for example, pick-up every Monday, BASIC REC every Tuesday, etc). If complex, please fill out a monthly calendar with details for each day of the month to help us keep up with your child's transportation changes. Questions? Call Front Office

Reporting Student Absences

When students will be absent, we request the parent/guardian notify the school by calling 540-662-4781 or emailing aprattnd@fcpsk12.net by 9:30 AM. Please state your name, the student's name, grade, teacher, and reason for absence. If your child has a medical or legal appointment, **a note** is required from that office in order to excuse the absence, tardy, or early release. The appointment verification note can also be **faxed** directly to the front office @ 540-722-3918.

**If you would like to pick-up homework for your child, please notify the office no later than 10:00 AM.

ARRIVAL TIME - School starts at **9:00 AM** (**Classroom accessible @ 8:45 AM; Breakfast accessible @ 8:30 AM**)

DISMISSAL TIME - **3:30 PM**. Normal dismissal begins with the calling of *BUSES* as they arrive, followed by *EVERYDAY PICKUPS*, then daily *SCHEDULED PICK UPS*, and finally *BASIC REC*. If your child has a "consistent change" on file in the front office, that child may be dismissed with the *Everyday Pickups* – be sure your child remembers; it will help make dismissal time a little easier!

Attendance Regulations

As per FCPS Attendance Regulations (410 R-A and 410 R-B)

Students may receive warnings, **detentions**, or **other school-based discipline** for excessive unexcused tardies, absences and early releases from school. Absences, tardies and early releases will be considered excused for reasons such as student illness, doctor, dentist & counseling appointments, pre-approved family vacations, court appointments, etc. Be sure to read the section titled *Attendance, Absence, and Tardiness in Grades K-5* in the Student and Parent Information handbook, which is available on the FCPS webpage. Please notify the APRES front office if you do not have internet access and need a copy of this handbook.

SAFETY & SECURITY at APRES

- Doors will be locked at all times. Please be patient and wait to be buzzed into the building by one of the office staff.
- For the safety of our students, Apple Pie Ridge asks that outside food is not brought into our school for class consumption by parents unless directed to do so by your child's classroom teacher. Allergies are a very serious issue and outside food creates a risk to our students. This particularly could impact student birthdays, so, as a parent or guardian, you may buy a book or pencils for the class on behalf of your child on his/her special day, but cupcakes and other foods will not go into the cafeteria. Thank you in advance for keeping our students safe!
- No flowers or balloons will be delivered to the classrooms. If this occurs, they will have to be picked up by the parent.
- No parents will be allowed upstairs during instruction unless it is prearranged with the teacher and they are on the approved volunteer list.

ELEMENTARY RESOURCE CLASS SCHEDULE FOR 2016-17

This year, all of Frederick County's elementary schools will be using a Day Number (i.e., Day 1, Day 2, Day 3, etc.) schedule for resource classes (art, library, PE and music) rather than the Monday-Friday schedule that's been used in previous years. The change will assure that students have the opportunity to attend all of their resource classes consistently regardless of school holidays and/or days missed due to inclement weather.

Each homeroom teacher will make students and parents aware of their classroom's resource schedule. Please note that school closings caused by inclement weather will result in resource day numbers changing.

FCPS Credit Card Payment System

FCPS is now using MySchoolBucks as its new online payment portal. MySchoolBucks will allow parents to view current cafeteria account balances, review recent purchases, receive low-balance alerts and setup recurring payments on a weekly or monthly basis. VISA and MasterCard are accepted 24 hours a day. Users will need to re-register for the system even if they used the online school payment system in the past. Visit your schools website and click on the MySchoolBucks link.
